Financial Policy

OMSS is a provider with most insurance companies in Tennessee and will file your insurance for you. We require proof of insurance at the time of your exam or you will be expected to pay for that visit.

It is your responsibility to verify whether or not your insurance company requires a referral. If so, you must have it at the time of your visit. If you do not have it, you will not be covered by your insurance.

We do require a deposit the day of surgery, but it is only an **estimate** of what will **not** be covered by your insurance. However, you are responsible for the full amount, regardless of insurance coverage, and you may receive a bill for any outstanding balance after your insurance pays.

If you do not have insurance, you will be expected to pay ½ down to schedule surgery and the balance paid on the day of surgery.

We do accept cash, checks and most major credit cards. We also accept Care Credit, which can be applied for at our office at the time of your exam.

We have a \$25 returned check fee and a \$175 fee for a missed surgery appointment.

Any unpaid balance remaining is considered delinquent after 90 days from treatment and is subject to a 2% monthly maintenance fee. Should I default on payment of my account, I agree to pay an additional 40% for collection agency fees and, if necessary, additional court costs and attorney fees. In the event this account is involved in litigation, I expressly waive any objection to venue and set venue will be Anderson County, Tennessee.
